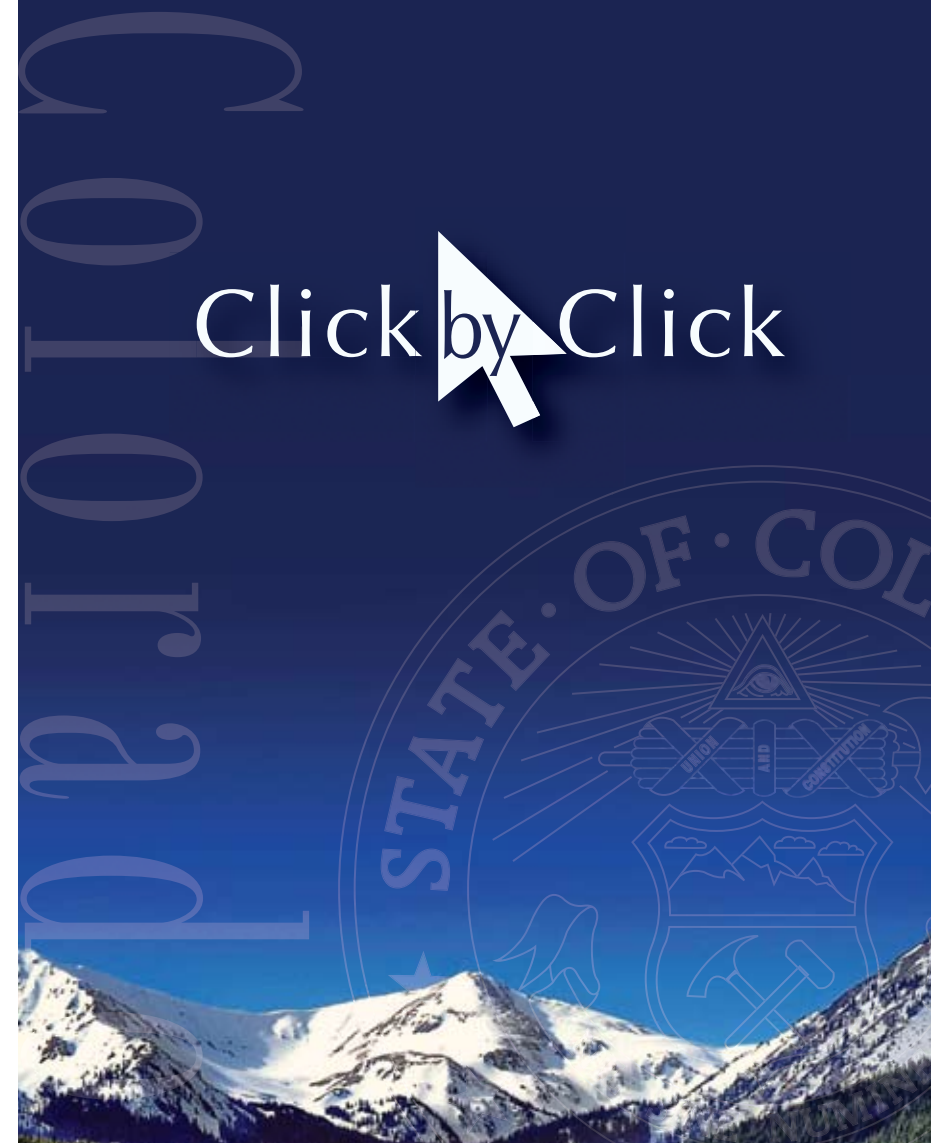

5 Labor Market Information Answers Many Business Questions

- To identify new potential customers, identify the industries that include your current customers.
 - Go to **Labor Market Analysis**.
 - Click on **Employers**.
 - Click on **Local Employer Sites**.
 - Choose the **Advanced Employer Search**.
 - Click on **Area (Click to Change)** and choose your geographic area. **HINT:** Keep your geographic area small.
 - On the same screen, find **Industry Title (Change)** and click on **(Change)**.

- Click on **Industries by Sector** tab and chose an industry where you have current customers. Click on that Industry and the subsector your customer is likely to be under.
- You will be returned to the Advanced Employer Search tab and screen. Click on **Search** at the bottom of the page and a list of other businesses/employers will appear.
- Return to the industries page for other industries and lists of businesses. Change your geographic area to review the same information in different counties.
- Use this same research method to find **potential business suppliers** or **business competitors**.
